

STUDENT DRESS CODEBoard Philosophy

The Board recognizes the need for students of the School to dress appropriately for school to increase student achievement, promote safety and enhance a positive school environment.

School Uniform Policy

In order to “Dress for Success” and create a unified student body, Tree of Life International Charter School will require a specific uniform dress code for students to wear on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday each week. The policy includes the following colors: Navy or white shirts or blouses with a collar; Navy or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers (No jeans). Wednesday will be designated as “Free Dress Day” each week, where students are not required to wear the uniform, but must follow the General Guidelines for dress. The School will offer logo shirts and logo hoodie sweatshirts for sale, though not required. In addition, school spiritwear will be offered for sale to wear on Wednesdays, field trips and special events.

General Guidelines

Inappropriate apparel includes clothing that compromises safety or is disruptive and/or distracting to the school environment and instructional process. No negative or racial messages, drug or alcohol advertisements, short shorts or skirts, open toed shoes or spaghetti straps will be permitted on any apparel. The Board is committed to protecting the health, safety, and welfare of the students and the Board believes that appropriate dress and grooming contribute to a productive learning environment.

Sun Protective Clothes

The code must allow students to wear sun protective clothing, including hats. However, specific hats determined by the School to be gang-related or inappropriate apparel may be prohibited.

Prohibited Conduct and Sanctions

Students who repeatedly violate the School Dress Code may be subject to discipline, including suspension and expulsion from School.
